Water, Sewer, Refuse and Recycling Programs

◆ **Water & Sewer Service:** Property owners receive a combined bill and meter reading statement every month. Sewer charges are also based upon your water meter readings. Meters are read electronically each month by the Public Works Department.

◆ **Refuse & Recycling Service:** Annandale's contracted refuse and recycling hauler is West Central Sanitation. Refuse is collected weekly. Recycling is collected every other week. Carts must be set out curbside by **7:00 a.m.** on the scheduled dates.

Tuesdays: North of Highway 55

Thursdays: South of Highway 55

You may contact West Central Sanitation at 800-246-7630 directly with questions or concerns about your service, or if you have extra items you would like picked up.

Commercial customers must contract for these services separately.

The City's refuse and recycling schedule is located on our website at www.annandale.mn.us.

RECYCLING

Cans, glass and plastic recyclables can all be placed in the recycle bin without separating them. Items must be rinsed and lids or caps should be removed from bottles and jars.

◆ GLASS

Acceptable:

- Brown, green and clear glass

Not Acceptable:

- Broken glass, window glass, ceramics, dishes or drinking glasses, light bulbs

◆ PLASTIC

Acceptable:

- Beverage containers, milk and water jugs, and laundry product containers

Not Acceptable:

- Plastic bags, styrofoam, toy, margarine tubs

◆ TIN & ALUMINUM CANS

Acceptable:

- Metal food cans, aluminum beverage cans

Paper and cardboard can also be recycled and should be separated from the mixed cans, bottles and jars as follows:

◆ PAPER

Acceptable:

- Bagged or bundled; clean and dry paper (including newspaper)

Not Acceptable:

- Wet paper, envelopes, and shredded paper

◆ CARDBOARD

Acceptable:

- Must be bundled and tied in stacks of not more than 2 feet x 2 feet
- Must be corrugated cardboard ONLY
- Minimal amounts accepted - Driver will use discretion. **A residential cardboard dumpster for large amounts is located at the City's compost site.**

COMPOST/CARDBOARD FACILITY

The City of Annandale's Compost Facility is located just past 551 Poplar Lane South. To access the facility, you will be given a unique entry code when you set up utility services. The compost site is open from 8:00 a.m. to dusk.

The site is designed for leaves, grass, small twigs, branches and garden vegetation. Brush should not be over 3" in diameter. No lumber, tree stumps, roots, dirt, sod, rocks, cement, etc.

Illegal dumping could result in a \$700 fine.

Current Rates (1/1/2024)

The current rate schedule for water, sewer, refuse and recycling services is as follows:

Water Usage Fee:

\$4.42 per 1,000 gallons used, plus a base charge of \$10.54 per month for residential and \$11.10 for commercial/industrial/institutional

Sewer Use Rates:

\$4.08 per 1,000 gallons based on metered water usage, plus a base charge of \$16.40 per month for residential and \$16.96 for commercial/industrial/institutional

Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP):

\$7.91 per 1,000 gallons based on metered water usage

Storm Sewer Rates:

\$3.25 per resident per month
\$4.25 per Comm/Industrial per month

Refuse Rates:

- 35 Gallons \$11.92/Month
- 35 Gallons Every Other Week \$10.55/month
- 64 Gallons \$13.75/Month
- 95 Gallons \$16.05/Month
- Recycling \$5.72/Month

Late Payment Fee \$15
Water Reconnection Penalty \$40
